

BIRBHUM: Hours after the Calcutta High Court ordered a Central Bureau of Investigation probe into the Birbhum violence, the CBI's forensic team reached Rampurhat on

The High Court sought a report that is to be submitted by April 7. The case was being investigated by an SIT formed by the West Bengal government. As many as eight people were burnt to death in the Rampurhat area of West Bengal's Birbhum on Tuesday after a mob allegedly set houses on fire following the killing of Trinamool Congress leader Bhadu Sheikh.

Srinagar-Leh NH opens

SRINAGAR: The Srinagar-Leh National Highway was opened for vehicular traffic on Friday after remaining closed for about three months, officials said. About 550 light motor vehicles were allowed to move from Sonamarg to Leh, a traffic police official told UNI. The highway was officially closed on January 5, 2022 following heavy snowfall after remaining open for a record time of almost ten months last year. The first convoy of the vehicles was flagged off from Sonamag towards Kargil by the Deputy Commissioner Ganderbal, Krittika Jyotsna. The highway was restored last Saturday after Border Roads Organisation (BRO), responsible for the maintenance of the highway, cleared the accumulated snow in a

Kashmiri Pandits file plea in SC on killing of Hindus in 90s

NEW DELHI: Roots in Kashmir, an NGO of Kashmiri Pandits, on Thursday filed a curative petition in the Supreme Court, seeking probe into the alleged killing of Pandits in the Valley during 1989-90. The curative petition was filed before the Apex Court, challenging its 2017 order, which had dismissed the NGO's petition for probe, citing long delay. On July 24, 2017, the Supreme Court had rejected the plea filed by the NGO, stating that it was difficult to have any probe and collect evidence on the issue more

Border peace foundation of stable ties, Jaishankar to Chinese FM Wang Yi

AGENCY NEW DELHI, MAR 25

External Affairs Minister (EAM) S Jaishankar on Friday said that peace and tranquillity at the border areas with China have been the foundation of stable and cooperative ties between the two countries.

He made these remarks after holding talks with Chinese Foriegn Minister Wang Yi in New Delhi that lasted for about three hours. Jaishankar said that he and his Chinese counterpart addressed a broad and substantive agenda in an open and candid manner.

"I would describe the current situation as work in progress, obviously at a slower pace than desirable. And my discussions with Foreign Minister Wang Yi today were aimed at expediting that process," Jaishankar told reporters here after delegation-level talks with Chinese

"The impact of the tension at the border areas on the overall relationship has been visible in the last two years. This is only natural since peace and tranquillity at the border areas have been the foundation of stable and cooperative ties. Indeed we have agreements designed to strengthen these foundations and



prevent the kind of situation that we

are seeing today," he added.

National Security Advisor (NSA) Ajit Doval on Friday told the visiting Chinese Foreign Minister Wang Yi that there has to be "early and complete disengagement" in border areas for Indo-China ties to move forward.

In a meeting between the Chinese Foreign Minister and NSA Doval, both countries emphasised that their actions should not violate the spirit of equal and mutual security, the government sources said.

The two Asian neighbours also concurred to work in the same direction and resolve outstanding issues as quickly as possible, the sources added. The Chinese Foreign Minister, who arrived in New Delhi on Thursday, held delegation-level talks with NSA Doval on Friday. In their meeting, the two sides emphasised on the need to continue positive interactions at diplomatic and military

Hope China follows independent policy on India

NEW DELHI: External Affairs Minister (EAM) S Jaishankar said on Friday that the remark made by Chinese Foreign Minister Wang Yi at the OIC meet, which had sparked a strong response from New Delhi, featured in the delegation-level talks between the two ministers. Speaking to reporters here after the talks between the two ministers, Jaishankar said he conveyed that India hopes that China would follow an independent policy in respect to New Delhi and will not allow its policies to be influenced by other countries.

Pakistan National Assembly session adjourned

The much-awaited session of Pakistan's National Assembly to take up the no-confidence motion against the Im-Khan-led Pakistan-Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) government has been adjourned to March 28 without the motion being tabled.

The session was adjourned shortly after tributes were offered to Khayal Zaman, a member of the house from the ruling PTI who had recently passed away. Citing parliamentary convention, speaker of the National Assembly Asad Qaiser said the first sitting after the death of a Member of the National Assembly (MNA) is limited to prayers for the soul of the departed and tributes fellow lawmakers wish to pay them, The Dawn reported. Qaiser asserted that he would conduct proceedings "as per rules and procedures" after which he adjourned the session till 4 pm on March 28. National Assembly Asad Qaiser has previously been slammed by the Opposition



for siding with Imran Khan and even attending the party meetings of the ruling PTI.

The National Assembly Secretariat had on Thursday evening issued a 15-point 'Orders of the Day' for the National Assembly session, which included the no-confidence motion. The development comes even as the Opposition parties had vowed to not allow any adjournment of the session without tabling of the motion. In a meeting on Thursday night, it was decided that the opposition would lodge strong protests if the proceedings were adjourned, media reports said. The Opposition parties had made elaborate preparations for the session. which demanded in a letter to the National Assembly speaker on March 8.




Awareness held on traffic

So if a person has a persistent cough, weight loss,



fever, or loss of appetite for two weeks or more, he may be suffering from TB. Get free medical advice and a free sputum check-up, chest X-ray, and CBNT test at the nearest government hospital. On this occasion, Kuldeep Singh Mann District Mass Media Officer and Harjit Singh District BC Coordinator said that TB treatment is provided free of cost by the government through the DOTS system and a TB patient is also given Rs.500/- per month for treatment.







EDITORIAL

Look back

he Centre has decided to lift Covid-19 restrictions, barring a few, by the end of March for the first time in two years. It is true that the infection rate has been falling — the country witnessed fewer than 2,000 cases in the last 24 hours. But this should not be seen as a signal to let the proverbial guard down. There has been a surge in Covid re-infections in some parts of the world, including the United States of America, China and South Korea. India, given its lax culture of civic consciousness, will continue to remain a potential target of the virus that seems to have resurrected itself.

There is, however, another pertinent issue. India needs to reflect on and learn from its experience during the period of Covid-induced restrictions. This phase bared some of the ugliest warts in governance, healthcare and, most strikingly, its body politic. There was the horror of government ineptitude when the nation was lashed by the first two waves of the pandemic. Searing images — be it of bodies floating on the Ganges or, earlier, migrant labourers trudging on deserted highways in a desperate bid to reach home bore evidence of the government's insensitivity. Meanwhile, the economy continued to tumble in the absence of meaningful interventions, magnifying public suffering. Equally shameful was the weaponization of no less than a health emergency to target minorities

— Muslims — by social and political segments that are fuelling India's unabashed march towards majoritarianism. There can be no greater evidence of the deterioration in — near-obliteration of — the pluralist ethos cemented in the constitutional vision. Rickety hospital infrastructure, the dissemination of unscientific concoctions as medical remedies as well as a tepid response to safety protocols were some of the other overwhelming features of this difficult time. Strangely enough, these marked failures have not elicited an electoral retribution on the ruling Bharatiya

If the last round of assembly elections were an indication, the BJP's policy failures on numerous fronts seem to have been brushed away by the electorate in these states. The last two years of suffering — India and the world are not out of the woods yet — have thus dismantled two entrenched assumptions. First, that a regime's failure during a health crisis brings collateral political damage. Second, that a pandemic is a medical crisis only. It is not. It wreaks equivalent social and economic costs. India is proof of that.

Rooftop gardens, greenery can turn down heat in cities

a ccording to research led by NASA's Goddard Institute for Space Studies, rooftop gardens and greenery can help ease some of the severe heat in cities. The findings of the research were published in the journal, 'Sustainable Cities and Society'.

For several decades, researchers have promoted replacing black tar and other dark-coloured roofing materials with bright, sun-reflecting surfaces or "green roofs" full of plant cover. Now they have used freely available satellite data to measure how effective these changes are.

Heat is often intensified or amplified in cities, a phenomenon known as the urban heat island effect. Asphalt, concrete, and similar materials absorb and retain significantly more heat than vegetation, so temperatures in urban areas are often 10 degrees Fahrenheit hotter than surrounding suburbs or rural regions. In neighbourhoods with fewer trees and green spaces, this heat often disproportionately affects older adults, low-income communities and some communities of colour.

Green roofs are designed to harness the cooling power of plants to lower the temperature in city spaces. The greenery may be extensive (shallow soil, low-maintenance plants) or intensive (deeper soil, more diverse plants and trees). The GISS team has studied three sites in Chicago to see how green roofs affected surface temperatures around those buildings, and whether there was a difference between those sites and others nearby without green roofs. Two of three green roofs in the study reduced temperatures, but results indicated that effectiveness may depend on location and plant diversity, among other factors.

"As cities grow and develop, they need to make good decisions about their infrastructure, because these decisions often last for 30 or 50 years or longer," said Christian Braneon, a climate scientist and civil engineer at Columbia University and GISS.

"In the context of more frequent heatwaves and more extreme heat, it's important to understand how these urban design interventions can be effective," Braneon added.

Braneon and the GISS team partnered with Chicago's

Public Health and Planning and Development departments to study three sites that had installed green roofs in the early 2000s: Millennium Park, City Hall, and a Walmart shopping centre. Using imagery captured by the Landsat 5 satellite between 1990 and 2011, the researchers have compared changes in land surface temperatures and vegetation abundance at the study sites as well as nearby control sites with-



out green roofs. Results from the three sites were mixed. Millennium Park, which has an intensive mix of plants and is located near Lake Michigan, showed significantly lower average temperatures after its green roof was installed in 2004. It was the only site where the roof fully mitigated climate warming over the study period.

City Hall, also an intensive site, had a green roof installed in 2002. Its temperatures after green roof installation were lower than those at the control site, but they were rising toward the end of the study period.

The Walmart site told a different story. While the green roofs at Millennium Park and City Hall were added onto existing buildings, the supermarket was newly built during the study period. Even though Walmart installed an extensive green roof, the conversion of the land from a vacant, grassy lot to a store meant the vegetation index for the landscape decreased.

"In a lot of places, you might be developing an area that didn't have something there before; it just had overgrown vegetation," said Braneon, who co-leads urban research for the Climate Impacts Group at GISS.

'You might think that putting a green roof on your new building would make a significant impact. But what we see is that a lot of impervious material may also be added there

- such as a parking lot around the building. As a result, you might reduce the impact of the parking lot, but you certainly haven't created the cooling effect that the overgrown vegetation had," Braneon added.

The benefits of green roofs depend on a variety of factors -- from the geographic region and plant diversity to rooftop structure and the cooling efficiency of the building tself, the scientists said.

Studies with larger sample sizes are needed to tease apart these details, but this study represented a promising start. With urban heat island effects expected to intensify as Earth's climate warms, it will become more important to understand these variables.

The study method is designed to be used by other cities for further research, said lead author Kathryn McConnell, a doctoral candidate at Yale University's School of the Environment. The simple analysis, publicly available data, and model for working directly with cities could help urban planners assess the viability of green roofs in their own areas. "My hope would be that the methods we proposed show a low-cost way for folks working in less-resourced cities - who maybe don't have access to a university or government researcher - to study their own communities," Mc-

Study finds link between artificial sweeteners and cancer risk

rtificial sweeteners reduce added sugar content and corresponding calories while maintaining sweetness. A new study sugare associated with increased cancer risk. The findings of the study were published in the journal 'PLOS Medicine'. To evaluate the potential carcinogenicity of artificial sweeteners, researchers analyzed data from 102,865 French adults participating in the NutriNet-Sante study. The NutriNet-Sante study is an ongoing web-based cohort initiated in 2009 by the Nutritional Epidemiology Research Team (EREN).

Participants enrol voluntarily and self-report medical history, sociodemographic, diet, lifestyle, and health data. Researchers gathered data concerning artificial sweetener intake from 24-hour dietary records.

After collecting cancer diagnosis information during follow-up, the researchers conducted statistical analyses to investigate the associations between artificial sweetener intakes and cancer risk. They also adjusted for a range of variables including age, sex, education, physical activity, smoking,



body mass index, height, weight-gain during follow-up, diabetes, family history of cancer, as well as baseline intakes of energy, alcohol, sodium, saturated fatty acids, fibre, sugar, wholegrain foods, and dairy products.

The researchers found that en-rollees consuming larger quantities of artificial sweeteners, particularly aspartame and acesulfame-K, had a higher risk of overall cancer compared to non-consumers (hazard ratio 1.13. 95 per cent confidence interval 1.03 to 1.25). Higher risks were observed for breast cancer and obesity-related can-

Rising food prices may prompt unrest in poor countries

orld Trade Organiza-tion (WTO) Direc-tor-General Ngozi Okonjo-Iweala said that food price growth that's happening Ukraine may prompt unrest among undernourished people in poverty-stricken countries.

"I think we should be very worried. The impact on food prices and hunger this year and next could be substantial. Food and energy are the two biggest items in the consumption baskets of poor people all over the world," Okonjo-Iweala said in an interview with The Guardian, adding that "it is poor countries and poor people within poor countries that will suffer the most."

The WTO chief went on to say that the WTO member countries should avoid the strategy of restricting the export of their own food supplies, providing an example of the so-called "vaccine apartheid" during the COVID-19 pandemic. "It is a natural reaction to keep what you



have -- we saw that with vaccines. But we shouldn't make the same mistake with food," she added. Okonjo-Iweala also said that Russian and Ukrainian wheat supplies account for 24% of the global market and that Ukraine provides about 50% of wheat to the World Food Programme, warning of a new possible catastrophe.

"If we don't think about how to mitigate the impact of the war that will be another


catastrophe, not just this year but next year," she said, adding that "we are talking to our members and urging them not to compound this crisis by having export restrictions on food." Ukraine and Russia remain the world's leading suppliers of wheat as well as sunflower, rapeseed, linseed and soybeans used for oil and animal feed. Half of the world's sunflower oil comes from Ukraine and another 21% from Russia.

Daily consumption of cranberries can improve cardiovascular health

ccording to a new clinical trial led by King's College, daily consumption of cranberries for one month can improve cardiovascular function in healthy men.

The findings of the study were published in the journal, 'Food & Function'. The study has included 45 healthy men who consumed whole cranberry powder equivalent to 110g of fresh cranberries per day (9 g powder) or a placebo for one month. Those consuming cranberry had a significant improvement in flow-mediated dilation (FMD), which signals improvement of heart and blood vessel function. FMD is considered a sensitive biomarker of cardiovascular disease



risk and measures how blood vessels widen when blood flow increases. Dr Ana Rodriguez-Mateos, the Senior

Lecturer in Nutrition at the Department of Nutritional Sciences at King's College London and senior author of the

study, said, "The increases in polyphenols and metabolites in the bloodstream and the related improvements in flow-mediated dilation after cranberry consumption emphasise the important role cranberries may play in cardiovas-

cular disease prevention."

He further added, "The fact that these improvements in cardiovascular health were seen with a number of cranberries that can be reasonably consumed daily makes cranberry an important fruit in the prevention of cardiovascular disease for the general public." Low consumption of fruits and vegetables is one of the top modifiable risk factors associated with a higher incidence of cardiovascular disease

worldwide. Growing evidence continues to link the polyphenols from berries with heart health benefits. Cranberries are rich in unique proanthocyanidins that have distinct properties compared to polyphenols found in other fruits.

This study explored whole cranberry freeze-dried powder, equivalent to 100g of fresh cranberries, and its impact on cardiovascular health. The results demonstrated that the consumption of cranberries as part of a healthy diet can help reduce the risk of cardiovascular disease by improving blood vessel function. An initial pilot study was completed with five healthy young men to confirm the biological activity powder. The pilot concluded that cranberry consumption increased FMD and confirmed dosing. The main study was a gold standard study design examining 45 healthy men each consuming two packets of whole cranberry freezedried powder equivalent to 100g of fresh cranberries, or a placebo, daily for one month.

The study found significant improvements in FMD two hours after first consumption and after one month of daily consumption showing both immediate and chronic benefit. In addition, metabolites were also identified and predicted the positive effects seen

Parents donate kidney and liver for daughter suffering from rare genetic disorder

URUGRAM /: Doctors at Artemis
Hospitals, Gurugram, performed a

transplant on a 37-year-old female patient from

lasted 16 hours. The parents of the patient donated
their own liver and kidney for their daughter who
was suffering from primary hyperoxaluria, a rare
genetic condition

present at birth. In this condition, the liver produces more quantities of a natural chemical called oxalate due to an enzyme defect, than what is required by the body. The extra oxalate combines with calcium to create stones and crystals in the kidneys, which can damage them and cause them to stop working (renal failure).

The patient remained unaware of her condition for years but

had begun to suffer from frequent headaches and vomiting. What she didn't know was that the gradual buildup of calcium deposits in her kidneys, a condition called nephron-calcinosis, had damaged their functioning severely. Doctors at a Srinagar hospital diagnosed the patient's condition as end stage kidney disease and put her on

dialysis. They recommended that she opt for a transplant and get a new liver (to prevent over-production of oxalate) and a new kidney (to replace the damaged ones). In the absence of a kidney transplant, she would need dialysis for the rest of her life. Her parents stepped in to help their child and readily agreed to donate their own organs for the purpose



IPL returns home, CSK to take on KKR in opener

AGENCY MUMBAI, MARCH 25

Cricket's cash-rich tournament, the Indian Premier League (IPL), is back home for its 15th edition in a bigger than ever form. The defending champions Chennai Super Kings (CSK) will take on the runners-up Kolkata Knight Riders (KKR) in the curtain raiser on March 26 at Wankhede Stadium. The tournament will see 10 teams battling it out for the coveted trophy, with Lucknow Super Giants and Gujarat Titans as the two new entrants.
