22 kg opium seized in Jalandhar

Farmers stop trains at various places in Punjab and Haryana

CHANDIGARH, MAR 10

Farmers stopped trains at various places in Punjab and Haryana as part of their Rail Roko protest.

Samyukt Kisan Morcha (non-political) and Kisan Mazdoor Morcha had given a call that trains would be halted at 60 places across Puniab and Harvana during their four-hour 'Rail Roko' from noon to 4 pm. At Ludhiana railway sta-

tion, harassed passengers were left with no other option and were seen leaving the railway station and opting for other modes of transport as trains were halted. Farmers also protested at the Patiala railway station. In Punjab, farmers had announced that they would sit on railway tracks at 52 locations in 22 districts, including Amritsar, Ludhiana, Tarn Taran, Hoshiarpur, Ferozepur, Fazilka, Sangrur, Mansa, Moga and Bathinda. Farmer leader Sarwan Singh Pandher has asked people to join the protest in large numbers. Farmers who have been protesting for almost one month now, squatted on railway tracks at many places in Punjab as part of a 'rail roko' protest called by the Samyukta Kisan Morcha (Non-Political) and the Kisan Mazdoor Morcha to press the Centre to ac-



cept their demands, including a legal guarantee of minimum support price (MSP) for their crops. Because of the disruption of train services, passengers experienced inconvenience. The protest was held from 12 noon till 4 pm.

Farmers blocked several railway tracks, including the Jalandhar Cantt railway tracks. Farmer leader Sarwan Singh Pandher, earlier in the day asked people to join the protest in large numbers.

'We urge all farmers, labourers and common people across the country to support us in the 'Rail Roko' today in large numbers. We also urge those, who are scheduled to travel on trains between 12 noon and 4 pm today, to push back their journey by a few hours today. Train passengers might face some inconvenience today. However, this is only a partial 'Rail Roko'," Pandher told ANI on Sunday. The protesting farmers have put forward a raft of demands before the Centre,

Special campaign launched against illicit liquor in across state, says Anil Vij

BUREAU CHANDIGARH, MAR 10

Haryana Home Minister Sh. Anil Vij said that on March 9 2024, the Haryana State Enforcement Bureau (H.S.E.B.) conducted a special campaign to crackdown on illegal activities such as illicit liquor and raw liquor in 22 districts of the state. A total of 45 FIRs were filed during this special campaign and 44 individuals were successfully arrested by seizing 4 vehicles. During this campaign, 345 liters of Lahan, 41.8 liters of raw liquor, 1021.75 bottles of country (Desi) liquor, 490.5 bottles of English liquor, and 504 bottles of beer were seized.

He informed that raids were conducted in 22 districts including Ambala, Kurukshetra, Panchkula, Yamunanagar, Faridabad, Palwal, Nuh, Gurugram, Mahendragarh, Rewari, Fatehabad, Jind, Hisar, Sirsa, Karnal, Panipat, Kaithal, Jhajjar, Charkhi Dadri, Rohtak, Sonipat, and Bhiwani. This special campaign of raids was conducted peacefully and without any tension.

Sh. Vij mentioned that during this campaign, a total of Lahan, one in Jind for 4.5 liters of raw liquor, one in Hisar for 22.5 liters of raw liquor, two FIRs in Karnal for 310 liters of Lahan, and two FIRs in Kaithal for 14.8 liters of raw liquor were successfully seized. The Home Minister said that in the case of illicit liquor, two FIRs were filed in Ambala for 52 bottles of country (Desi) liquor, resulting in the arrest of two accused. Time to reimagine, build up India as an Asian hub

he Indian subcontinent has been so named for a reason. India's large, diamond-shaped landmass sits squarely between West Asia and East Asia. Its southern peninsula extends significantly into the Indian Ocean, and to the north lie the resource-rich but landlocked countries of Central Asia. This geographic location at the lit eral crossroads of Asia makes India a potential linchpin in the building of an Asian Century. A century in which the energy suppliers of West Asia feed the energy consumers of East Asia and the resource-rich but landlocked countries of Central Asia find export markets through the dozen ports that India has on the India Ocean. Moreover, India sits astride some of the most critical Sea Lanes of Commerce (SLOC's) that run from West to East and visa-versa. Also India's extremity in the Andaman Nicobar Islands, Indira Point, lies mere 675 kilometres from the Straits of Malacca, dominating the six-degree chan-

The Indian Ocean region (IOR) also contains China's most important SLOCs. As much as 75 per cent of China's oil imports come from the Middle East and Africa. China imports more than 11.28 million barrels daily. The interplay between India, China, Russia, Japan and South Korea constitutes the economic fulcrum of the Asian power dynamic. There are, of course, other rising powers in Asia that have carved out vital niches for themselves. Asia's has been the fastest growing economy in the world this century, and will continue to be so for the foreseeable decades. Trade between Asian countries has boomed and grown faster than world trade in every year in the past



quarter century, driven in part by the aggressive growth of China and in part by an East Asia linking its markets and supply chains. But there is a giant piece missing in the story: To realize its full potential, an Asian century requires India as a connector, as a processor of goods that Asia requires, as a provider of services such as transport and logistics, efficient trading markets and bourses, and financial services that underpin trade, such as credit and insurance, and as a continent-sized consumer market for the products of Asian countries. This connection has been the missing piece that can exponentially power India's

growth provided it is able to shed the baggage of history qua Pakistan and find a modus vivendi with China on the unsettled border question that in its latest manifestation has been bedevilling the relationship between these two countries over the past four years now.

What does the realisation of India's Asian potential require? It would require a mind shift by India to start viewing its neighbours as opportunities rather than threats. A leap of faith that to make is easier said than done. It would requires cooperation rather than competition among Asian and Indian Ocean countries; it requires a

strategic approach to building the Asian economy of tomorrow, including infrastructure that will connect Asia through India, regulatory frameworks, and the international alliances and border settlements that will allow the economic potential to be realised peacefully. This would be a major shift from India's present thrust. Currently, the United States and Europe are India's largest and second largest markets for its exports. Asian countries' share of India's trade has grown in recent years with the economic growth of those countries, but there is both much more potential, and the need for a systematic effort to fully realise India's potential at the centre of Asia. After India opted out of the RCEP, many leading voices in East Asia expressed disappointment, but also argued that an Asian century will go ahead in some form, with or without India. But an Asia without India is fragmented into an East Asia and a West Asia, a Central Asia and an Indian Ocean Asia. India brings all of these together and therein lies the genius of India.

There are 28 countries have a coastline on the Indian Ocean. Together, they have a GDP of almost \$11 trillion, and a population of almost 2.8 billion. Add to these the six landlocked countries of Central Asia which cover a vast resource-rich territory and are sparsely populated, and Mongolia, Russia's Siberia, as well as China would benefit from having energy and resource routes through to the Indian Ocean and the Arabian Sea. The Himalayas are an inhospitable environment in which to build infrastructure, but the technology to do so, including the boring of tunnels, is now fairly well-developed.

Do you know obesity is a risk factor for stillbirth? Study finds

besity increases the risk of stillbirth as the pregnancy progresses to full term, according to a study. The study findings were published in Canadian Medical Association Journal (CMAJ).

In Canada, the overall risk of still-birth during pregnancy is roughly 0.4 per cent. "Our findings suggest that an earlier delivery date may help reduce the risk of stillbirth for pregnant people with obesity," said lead author Dr Naila Ramji, an assistant professor at Dalhousie University and high-risk pregnancy specialist in Fredericton, New Brunswick. Senior author Dr Laura Gaudet, an associate professor at Queen's University and high-risk pregnancy specialist, and coauthors at The Ottawa Hospital round out the group.

Although the link between obesity and stillbirth is well-known, there was little research on the association between obesity and stillbirth risk by gestational age, or on the impact of higher classes of obesity.

To address this gap, the researchers analysed data from Better Outcomes Registry and Network on 681 178 singleton births, 1956 of which were stillbirths, in Ontario between 2012 and 2018. After adjusting for other stillbirth risk factors like diabetes and high blood pressure, the researchers found that people with class I obesity (BMI 30-34.9 kg/m2) had double the risk of stillbirth at 39 weeks' gestation



compared to those with normal BMI (18.5-24.9 kg/m2). For those in obesity classes II and III (BMI 35-39.9 kg/m2 and BMI 40 kg/m2 and higher, respectively), stillbirth risk at 36 weeks was 2 to 2.5 times that of people with normal BMI. This risk further increased with gestational age, with a more than fourfold risk at 40 weeks. "For other medical conditions that increase the risk of stillbirth. there are guidelines that recommend delivery at 38 or 39 weeks. Interestingly, the risk thresholds for those conditions are lower than the risks we found associated with obesity. We worry that implicit biases against people with obesity may be causing the medical community to take the risks they face less seriously," says Dr

Scientists develop blood-based marker to spot acute sleep deprivation



team of scientists has developed a blood test that can detect when someone has not slept for 24 hours, also called sleep deprivation. This level of sleep deprivation increases the risk of serious injury or fatality in safety critical situations, according to experts at Monash University in Australia and the University of Birmingham in the UK.

The biomarker detected whether individuals had been awake for 24 hours with a 99.2 per cent probability of being correct, according to the study published in the journal Science Advances.

"This is a really exciting discovery for sleep scientists, and could be transformative to the future management of health and safety relating to insufficient sleep," said Clare Anderson, a professor of Sleep and Circadian Science at the University of Birmingham in the UK. With about 20 per cent of road accidents worldwide caused by sleep deprivation, researchers hope the discovery may inform future tests to quickly and simply identify sleep deprived drivers.

"There is strong evidence that less than five hours' sleep is associated with unsafe driving, but driving after being awake for 24 hours, which is what we detected here, would be at least comparable to more than double the Australian legal limit of alcohol performance wise," Anderson added.


The test may be also ideal for future forensic use but further validation is required. This sleep deprivation biomarker is based on 24 hours or more awake, but can detect down to 18 hours awake.

Germany's genocide hypocrisy regarding Gaza

A lmost four months have passed since massacres were launched by Israel against Palestinians in Gaza. According to the latest data from the Palestinian authorities, more than 25,000 innocent people have lost their lives in Gaza so far due to Israel's ongoing slaughter, with the number of injured being approximately three times this figure. Despite Israel's efforts to justify these massacres as self-defense against Hamas, it is undeniable that Israel is committing outright genocide against the Palestinians.

What is even more distressing is that Western countries, often presenting themselves as champions of democracy and human rights, support the genocide



in Gaza. Among these countries, Germany, grappling with its historical burden from the Holocaust, stands out. Ger-

many is noted as one of the nations providing significant support to the ongoing massacres in Gaza since Oct. 7. Prime Minister Olaf Scholz, during his visit to Tel Aviv on Oct. 17, declared Berlin's unwavering support for Israel in his meeting with Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, the "butcher of Gaza."

Following Scholz's visit, President
Frank-Walter Steinmeier paid a visit to
Tel Aviv in November and stated that
since Israel is defending itself against
"terrorists" it cannot be condemned. In
other words, Berlin believes that Israel
can massacre any Palestinian in Gaza to
maintain its existence. Moreover, Germany requested to intervene in the case
that South Africa filed with the Interna-

tional Court of Justice on the grounds that Israel committed genocide in Gaza, and it argued that there is no genocide. The Scholz government cited Germany's special responsibility toward Israel as the reason for this brazenness.

What is this special responsibility that causes Berlin to support Israel's oppression? Essentially, to understand this responsibility and the reasons why Germany defends the massacre in Gaza, it is necessary to remember the genocide committed against the Jews in Germany during World War II.

As known, after Adolf Hitler was elected chancellor in 1933, a state-led institutional policy of marginalization against Jews began in Germany. As a result of a process that changed dimensions over time and reached racism, Nazi Germany embarked on a systematic massacre to completely exterminate the Jewish lineage. Although the figures are controversial, it is thought that the Nazis murdered approximately 6 million Jews until 1945. The series of massacres described as the Holocaust in the literature is considered the bloodiest genocide in human history. It should be noted here that there is no logical explanation for Netanyahu's lie that "Hitler wanted to exile the Jews, but a Palestinian mufti gave him the idea to massacre the Jews."

Germany's lesser-known genocide record

By the way, although the words

"Germany" and "genocide" are often read in terms of the Holocaust, it must be said that Germany's genocide record is quite extensive. While imperial Germany plundered

While imperial Germany plundered Namibia in the southwest of Africa, which it colonized in the late 19th century, it committed a bloody genocide between 1904 and 1908 to intimidate the natives who wanted to protect their lands. At least 75,000 locals were brutally murdered as a result of the four-year genocide carried out by the colonial Germans. After a century, Germany accepted the crimes committed in Namibia as genocide in a statement made in 2021 but refused to pay compensation for those who lost their lives.




