Police seize Rs 5.6 cr cash, 106 kg jewellery in Ballari

BALLARI : Ahead of Lok Sabha elections, the Karnataka police seized cash worth Rs 5.60 crore along with 106 kg of gold and silver ornaments in Ballari district, officials said on Monday.

One person has been taken into custody in connection with the case, they said. "Rs 5.60 crore in cash, 3 kg of gold, and 103 kg of silver jewellery with 68 silver bars have been seized. An individual has been taken into custody for questioning," police said. "We are further looking into the matter," they said.

BJP's Salaria revolts against party, says will contest LS polls from Gurdaspur

CHANDIGARH: BJP leader Swaran Salaria on Monday declared that he will contest the Lok Sabha elections from Gurdaspur, where his party has already announced a candidate. He also ruled out contesting as an Independent and said he will fight on the symbol of a "good party". "It will be clear by April 13. It will be a good and winning party," Salaria said.

JJP leader Kamlesh Saini quits party

CHANDIGARH: In a setback to the party ahead of Lok Sabha polls, Jannayak Janta Party's general secretary Kamlesh Saini on Monday quit the party while speculation was rife that the JJP's state unit chief Nishan Singh has also decided to leave the outfit.

In her resignation letter to the JJP's national president Ajay Singh Chautala, Saini said, "I am resigning from the primary membership of the JJP and from all the posts I hold". Saini said she has taken the decision keeping in view the sentiments and feedback from her supporters.

4 killed, over 12 injured in road accident in Kapurthala

KAPURTHALA: Four people were killed and more than a dozen injured in a collision between two cars on the Kapurthala-Goindwal road in Punjab, police said on Monday.

Delhi excise policy: ED questions Kejriwal's PA, AAP MLA Pathak

The Enforcement Directorate on Monday questioned Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal's personal assistant Bibhav Kumar and AAP MLA Durgesh Pathak in the excise policy-linked money laundering case, officials said.

Their statement is being recorded under the provisions of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA), they said.

Both of them have been questioned in this case earlier too by the ED.

Sources said Kumar's questioning was essential in connection with the engagements of Kejriwal. The 55-year-old CM, also the national convener of the AAP, was arrested by the ED in this case last month. He is currently lodged in the Tihar Jail under judicial custody.

The agency had alleged in its earlier charge sheets that at least 36 accused, including former Delhi Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia and Kumar, "destroyed, used or changed" 170 phones to conceal evidence of "kickbacks" worth thousands of crores of rupees in the alleged scam.

The IMEI (International Mobile Equipment Identity) of Bibhav's mobile number is stated to have been changed four times between September 2021 and July 2022, according to the ED charge sheet filed before a local court last year.

Pathak, the 35-year-old AAP MLA from Rajinder Nagar constituency, is understood to have been called by the agen-

cy for questioning in connection with the party's 2021-22 poll campaign for the Goa assembly polls. The ED has alleged that Rs 45 crore "kickbacks", out of the Rs 100 crore "bribe" provided by the 'South Group', were used by the AAP for this campaign.



Delhi HC's verdict on Kejriwal's plea today

NEW DELHI: The Delhi High Court will pronounce its verdict on Tuesday (tomorrow) on Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal's plea challenging his arrest and Enforcement Directorate remand in the Excise Liquor Policy Scam Case. The court on Wednesday reserved a verdict on the plea moved by Arvind Kejriwal challenging his arrest by the ED. Besides his arrest, Kejriwal also challenged his subsequent remand in the Enforcement Directorate's custody. He was later remanded in judicial custody and lodged in Tihar jail.

Court denies interim bail to BRS leader Kavitha

NEW DELHI: The Rouse Avenue court in the national capital on Monday dismissed the detailed interim bail application of Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) MLC K Kavitha. She had sought interim bail on the grounds that her minor son had school examinations.

She is in judicial custody after the ED remand in the excise policy case. Special judge Kaveri Baweja had dismissed the interim bail application this morning. A detailed bail order has yet to be uploaded.

The bail application of the BRS leader was opposed by the counsel for ED, who argued that Kavitha destroyed the evidence in her phone and that witnesses were forced to retract their statements.

Kavitha had filed an application seeking interim bail given the examination of her school going son. Advocates Nitesh Rana and Deepak Nagar also appeared for her. At the outset, it was argued that being a woman, the rigours of the twin condition under Section 45 of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA) do not apply to K Kavitha. Senior advocate Abhishek Manu Singhvi had submitted that when a person falls under exceptions, the twin condition does not apply to that person. As per Section 45 of PMLA women fall under the category of exceptions for granting bail by the court, Singhvi said.

Gold rush continues; silver also touches new high

In line with the trend in the foreign markets, gold continued its shine and touched a record high of Rs 73650 per 10 grams for standard gold which is 24-carat while silver is also on the rise with Rs 82,000 per kg.

The ornamental is 22-carat gold hovered around Rs 65,000 per 10 grams.

According to Motilal Oswal Financial Services Ltd Precious Metal Quarterly Report, silver will be strongly positive for the next few months. According to its estimates, silver is likely to touch

Rs 92,000 to Rs 1 Lakh per kg over the next few months. According to traders the speculative buying and geopolitical situation especially in the middle-east is also the reason behind record high prices of both gold and silver. Geopolitical tensions have continuously built in risk premium in the market and it has been seen year after year since 2020. In 2022 it was the Russia-Ukraine war, and last year conflict between Israel and the Hamas group, all these provided support to safe-haven assets like gold and silver. Bullion prices are subject to many factors that shape supply and demand dynamics in the market.

In Prashant Kishor's poll prediction; East, South warning for opposition

Less than two weeks before the general election, poll strategist Prashant Kishor sounded a red alert for the Congress and INDIA opposition bloc, warning of improved performances - seats + vote share - by Prime Minister Narendra Modi's Bharatiya Janata Party across six eastern and southern states.

Mr Kishor - who has guided the Congress, the Trinamool, and the Aam Aadmi Party to wins over the Prime Minister's BJP - repeated his warnings of the past - that the ruling party is not invincible.

But he also warned the opposition it is running out of chances to stop the BJP juggernaut, pointing to a string of missed opportunities between 2016 and

2018, as well as the pandemic. "If you drop catches, the batter will score a century... especially if he is a good batter," he told news agency.

"They (the BJP) will either be first or second in Telangana... which is a big thing. They will be No 1 in Odisha for sure. Also, you would be surprised... to my mind the BJP is going to be No 1 in Bengal," Mr Kishor said, flagging states in each of which the party has lost the most recent Assembly election.

"In Tamil Nadu, the party may hit double-digit vote share," he said. For context, the BJP's vote share in the 2019 Lok Sabha election was 3.6 per cent and only 2.6 per cent in the 2021 Assembly poll.

These are parts of the country the BJP has, in the past, struggled for traction, with its hardcore nationalist ideol-



ogy not quite resonating with voters; in 2014 and 2019 it won only seven and 30 of the 164 seats across Telangana, Odisha, Bengal, Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, and Kerala.

The exception was Karnataka, where the BJP won 25 of 28 seats in 2019.

That said, many believe the party has been weakened here too after the Congress' big win in last year's Assembly election.

Fast-forward five years, though, and the BJP's persistent outreach and boots-on-the-ground approach in these regions could pay (relatively) big dividends, which will boost the party profile for forthcoming polls even if it does not translate into success for the 2024 Lok Sabha election.

Three of these six states - Bengal, Kerala, and Tamil Nadu - will vote by 2026. The BJP has made a "major and visible push" to expand in these states, Mr Kishor said, pointing to repeat visits by the Prime Minister and Home Minister Amit Shah, the party's two biggest hitters.

History sheeter shot dead in Prayagraj

A history sheeter was shot dead by unidentified persons in Nawabganj area of Prayagraj district here in Uttar Pradesh, police sources said here on Monday.

Police sources said that on Sunday information was received that a youth having injuries was

lying in the orchard behind a private hospital in Kaurihar. "During investigation it was revealed that two more persons were present on the spot, but they escaped," they said.

Police sources said that the injured person was identified as Rituraj (26), a history sheeter of Nawabganj police station. "Several cases are lodged

against Rituraj in Nawabganj and Jaunpur," they said.

Police sources said that the injured criminal was admitted to Swarup Rani Nehru hospital where he succumbed to injuries late on Sunday night. "It is being probed whether the bullet fired accidentally, or Rituraj was shot by his aides over some dispute," they said.

Illicit liquor, drugs, and cash worth Rs 14 crore seized in Haryana

In view of the Lok Sabha elections various agencies are closely monitoring the sale of illegal liquor and drugs in Haryana. So far, illicit liquor and drugs worth over Rs 10.5 crore and cash worth Rs 3.62 crore have been seized in the state. Chief Electoral Officer, Haryana, Sh. Anurag Agarwal stated that the action has

been taken by the police, Income Tax Department, Excise and Taxation Department, and Directorate of Revenue Intelligence (DRI) in the state after the imposition of the Model Code of Conduct. He said that the police had seized Rs 40.22 lakh in cash, liquor worth Rs 225.57 lakh (70,671.54 litres), drugs worth Rs 514.48 lakh, and other items worth Rs 56.81 lakh.

Monarch's Realm Intruded: Celebrity culture takes center stage

All Eyes on Kangana Ranaut's Mandi Parliamentary Seat

In the 18th Lok Sabha elections of the country, the 'Mandi' seat of Himachal Pradesh has not only attracted the attention of the nation but has also been buzzing with its spectacular entry into Bollywood politics. Mandi, which used to be the market of kings, is seeing a new bloom of stage politics. By fielding the Rajput Bollywood actress Ranaut on this excellent and already highly favorable seat, the BJP has courted several controversies. It was also a convenient seat for the BJP because out of the 10 assembly constituencies in Mandi

district, 9 were already in the BJP's kitty, and the BJP's vote margin in the remaining assembly constituencies of the Mandi parliamentary seat was very low in 2022. However, by fielding Kangana Ranaut from this seat, the BJP suddenly found itself embroiled in controversies at the national level, especially since Kangana already had many well-wishers from Bollywood. The direct impact of the "Jagati Samaj" of Himachal Pradesh on this actress and candidate who is constantly trolled on social media is evident. It is another matter that Kangana's social media guardian is also putting up a tough fight.

However, the Congress has not yet clarified its cards regarding its probable candidate. As soon as the candidate is announced, the star attraction will take on a new form.

The politics of the Mandi seat in Himachal Pradesh has been controversial as well as interesting because those contesting from here have never been from an ordinary background. Maheshwar Singh from the royal family won three times, Virbhadra Singh twice, his wife Pratibha Singh twice, former Union Minister Pandit Sukh Ram three times. Virbhadra belonged to the Bushehar princely state, Maheshwar to Kullu, and Sukh Ram hailed from Mandi district. Moreover, even Jairam Thakur was defeated from here. However, after becoming the Chief Minister, he gained such a strong foothold in Mandi that Ram Swaroop, associated with the RSS, won handsomely in 2019. But when he committed suicide in Delhi, Pratibha Singh won again with 49.23 percent of the votes, even though the BJP's Jairam

government was in power in the state at that time.

Overall, the Mandi seat elections take on a new direction and dimension every time. The BJP has placed its bet on celebrity Kangana. However, even before Kangana's candidature was announced, Pratibha Singh had declared that she would not contest. It was believed that Pratibha did not want to come forward due to the Modi wave. That's why she also talked about the neglect of workers in her own government in Mandi. Amid this, as soon as Kangana's candidature was announced from Delhi, accompanied by a blitzkrieg of social media commentary, the Mandi seat became super hot. While the party workers in Mandi were thrilled to see the superstar in person, the senior party leaders in Mandi were overshadowed by Kangana's pres-

ence. Although the outspoken Kangana refuted the allegations in Mandeali, the local voters who speak Pangi, Lahul, Rampur, Chhatra, Saraj, and Mandi dialects were perplexed by her mixed Bilaspuri and Sarkaghati dialect. After all, Kangana's next challenge would be to speak these local dialects as well.

In fact, the Mandi parliamentary constituency has 17 assembly segments, including four from Kullu district and one each from Chamba, Kinnaur, Lahaul-Spiti, and Shimla districts. Mandi has 9 seats, which means that the Mandi parliamentary area covers 6 districts, and all 6 districts have different dialects.

In these 17 assembly constituencies, there is a close contest between the two parties. However, the BJP gets a substantial vote share from Jairam's seat in Saraj,

Anil Sharma's seat in Mandi, Janak Raj's seat in Bharmour, and Rakesh Jamwal's seat in Sundarnagar. Kangana's weight also increases due to these BJP seats in Mandi district.

But the challenges are not few either. As the campaign picks up pace, the Congress will launch a full-fledged attack. Whether it's Kangana's pictures, her outspoken statements, or issues related to her diet and lifestyle that go against the ideology of the Sangh and the party, they will create hurdles for her.

The influence and resentment of the large Dev community led by BJP's senior leader and former MP Maheshwar Singh from Kullu will not make Kangana's path as smooth as it could have been for an ordinary worker like Ram Swaroop. If the Virbhadra family jumps into the fray, then the unity of the royal family and the Devlu community will also show its impact in the region.

Four held for misusing Kaithal ARO ID

RANVIR PARASHAR KAITHAL: The district police have arrested four persons in connection with the case of misusing the ID and password of Assistant Returning officer Kaithal, parliamentary constituency Kurukshetra, to access the portal and making derogatory post therein, said Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP) Gurvinder Singh. He said that the accused were identified as Shivang, Parveen and Ashish, all residents of Radhaswami colony Kaithal. Fourth accused was identified as Vishal of Teontha village in the district. The DSP said that as per the complaint of ARO Kaithal, applications regarding permission for public meeting were received through the online portal on April 3. An unknown person misused the ARO ID, canceled the application forms and uploaded objectionable comments and photos. Taking the action, a case was registered at cyber police station Kaithal in this regard. He further said that accused Shivang and Parveen were arrested on Saturday. While accused Ashish and Vishal were arrested on Monday and two mobile phones used in the crime were also recovered from them.

The Suvidha Portal streamlined the process of obtaining and acting upon requests for permissions and facilities from political parties and candidates during the election period.

The Chief Electoral Officer said that recognizing the importance of the election campaign period, where parties and candidates engage in activities to reach out to voters, the Suvidha Portal caters to a diverse range of permission requests transparently on the First in First Out principle. It caters to permissions for or-

ganizing rallies, opening temporary party offices, door-to-door canvassing, video vans, helicopters, obtaining vehicle permits, and distributing pamphlets. Sh. Anurag Agarwal said that political parties and candidates can seamlessly submit permission requests online from anywhere, at any time. Additionally, offline submission options are available to ensure inclusivity and equal opportunity for all stakeholders. Suvidha also has a companion app that enables applicants to track the status of their requests in real time, adding further convenience and transparency to the process. Furthermore, the permission data available on the portal serves as a valuable resource for scrutinising election expenditures, contributing to greater accountability and integrity in the electoral process, he added.



1st April to be qualifying date to enroll new voters for upcoming elections: CEO

As per latest amendments in the law, the Election Commission of India has further elaborated new guidelines for enrollment of first voters. Stating here this today Chief Electoral Officer (CEO) Maneesh Garg, said that the qualifying dates for registration for new voters who has attained the age of 18 years as on 1st of either of the months viz. January, April, July or October were eligible to get themselves enrolled in the voters list instead once in a year as was the practice earlier. The changes have been made by the ECI to facilitate the first voters to get themselves enrolled in the voters list four times in a year for exercising their right to



franchise during the elections. In view of these amendments, those citizens who have attained the age of 18 years as on 1st April, 2024 can also register themselves as voters for casting their votes in the upcoming Lok Sabha elections in Himachal Pradesh, he remarked.

He was chairing the meeting of State Systematic Voters Education & Electoral Participation (SVEEP) core committee held here today. The new

voters can also check their name in the voters list by downloading the Voters Helpline App (VHA) from Google play and the new voters need to register themselves by filling up the Form-6. The CEO emphasized upon the need to make the youth aware about the misconception that if they have voted for the Panchayat elections they were also automatically eligible to vote in Lok Sabha or Vidhan Sabha elections, which is not correct.

State Tax and Excise Department's major haul, seizes 52,440 litres of illicit liquor

Excise Commissioner Yunus revealed today that the State Tax and Excise Department has taken significant strides in curbing illegal liquor activities across various districts in the State. A total of 52,440 litres of illicit liquor have been seized in district Bilaspur, Nurpur, Kangra, Sirmour, Mandi, Una, Chamba and Kullu. He said that to enforce strict actions against illegal liquor operations the department has also deployed 59 task force teams and flying squads throughout the state.

He said that a remarkable 240,438 litres of illicit liquor have been confiscated from different regions of the state since the implementation of the Model Code of Conduct in the state. These efforts carried out in collaboration with nodal officers from neighbouring states, have targeted illegal



liquor businesses within border areas and the state itself. Recently, the department uncovered and confiscated 100 boxes of country liquor unlawfully stored in Chamba district, invoking the provisions of the Excise Act, 2011, added the excise commissioner. Additionally, the South Zone Flying Squad intercepted 1,724 litres of liquor in Sirmour district. Notably, joint operations with local law enforcement led to the destruction of 1200 litres of illicit liquor extraction facilities in Dhelti village of

district Bilaspur, underscoring the commitment to eradicating such activities. He said that recovery and destruction of 2,000 litres of Lahan in the Indora area coordinated efforts with Punjab Excise teams have been done. Similarly, the Excise team of Kangra district, in collaboration with the police, confiscated many boxes of illegally stored country liquor. Yunus said that in light of the forthcoming elections in Himachal Pradesh, the department remains vigilant and is collaborating closely with

border state excise officials and the Himachal Police to prevent any illegal activities related to liquor in the State. He said that the department maintains a zero-tolerance policy towards illegal liquor operations, promising continued vigilance and stringent actions in the future. He said that to further enhance public participation in curbing such activities, a dedicated control room has been established in the state which is ensuring round-the-clock surveillance. Names in foreign languages that may harm China's territorial claims and sovereignty rights shall not be directly quoted or translated without authorization. The Chinese Ministry of Civil Affairs released the first list of standardized names of six places in Arunachal Pradesh

in 2017. The second list of new names of 15 places was released in 2021. After this, another list of names of 11 places was released in 2023. China's recent statements to assert its claim over Arunachal Pradesh began during Prime Minister Narendra Modi's visit to the state. On March 9, PM Modi had inaugurated the Sela Tunnel built at an altitude of 13 thousand feet in Arunachal Pradesh. China lodged diplomatic protest with India over PM Modi's visit. When the US said that it recognized Arunachal Pradesh as Indian territory, China opposed it. Said that the India-China border dispute is an issue between the two countries.

Kharar police arrests one on charges of selling renting luxury cars on fake documents

Kharar city police has arrested an accused named Tanish Sharma on the charge of renting self-drive vehicles and selling them by preparing fake documents. A case under Section 406, 419, 420, 465 have been registered against him in Kharar city police station.

Kharar DSP Mr. Karan Singh Sandhu while giving information regarding this today said that accused is studying at a University in Ghauran. He hired luxury vehicles for Self Drive from the owner of Rudra Company Kharar and then prepared fake documents and sell them at cheap rates to the customers.

The police have seized a SUV from him, which he had taken on rent and was planning to resell. He said that during interrogation, the accused told that he had sold a Varna vehicle to a resident of Mohali for rupees 6 lac 50 thousand and he had recovered 2 lakh 55 thousand rupees from him and there was a negotiation to get the remaining loan. Another vehicle was sold to a resident of Patiala and received one and



a half lakh rupees from him. During interrogation, the accused told that he had hired 2 vehicles from a firm of Chandigarh and sold one of

them to a Patiala customer and got rupees 5 lac from him. Similarly, the second vehicle Varna was sold to a resident of Haryana and Rs 5 lakh

was taken from him. DSP said that both vehicles have been recovered. In this way, the police have recovered a total of 5 vehicles from him so far.

ADC, SDM oversee rescue operations by reaching spot

Prompt action by District Administration Sahibzada Ajit Singh Nagar helped to contain fire erupted at a Chemical factory at Behra road, Derabassi by late evening (7:55 pm) to keep the surrounding community out of risk successfully, said the Deputy Commissioner, Mrs Aashika Jain, here, today.

dar Birkaran Singh and SHO Ajitesh Kaushal reached the spot immediately. The whole operation was overseen by the ADC and SDM till the control was on fire, she added.

ADC Viraj S Tidke said that Fire teams under the directions of Fire Officer, Derabassi, Jaswant Singh successfully contained the fire from further broke out and efforts are ongoing to extinguish any remaining hotspots.

There have been no reported casualties or injuries resulting from this incident, and the surrounding communities are not at immediate

risk, said the Additional Deputy Commissioner by adding that a thorough search operation would be resumed tomorrow to check any further loss.

The Deputy Commissioner said that the District Administration is working closely with the management of Maggo Chemical and Pharmaceutical to ensure that all necessary measures are taken to address the aftermath of the fire effectively and will also work in collaboration with relevant regulatory bodies to enforce safety protocols and prevent similar occurrences in the future.

PM Modi's degree row: SC dismisses AAP MP Sanjay Singh's plea to quash summons

The Supreme Court on Monday refused to intervene in the summons issued to Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) leader and Rajya Sabha MP Sanjay Singh by a trial court in the Criminal defamation case. This summons is part of a Criminal defamation case filed against Singh by Gujarat University regarding his comments on Prime Minister Narendra Modi's academic credentials.

A bench comprising Justice BR Gavai and Justice Sandeep Mehta dismissed Sanjay Singh's petition to quash the summons issued to him by an Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate of Gujarat. The Gujarat High Court had earlier refused to grant Singh any relief in the matter, and the Supreme Court upheld the High Court's decision.



While refusing to entertain Singh's appeal the Apex Court told Senior advocate Abhishek Manu Singhvi appearing for Singh, "We are not inclined to entertain this plea. Sorry,"

Besides, Sanjay Singh, the name of Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal also figures in the Defamation case filed in a Gujarat District Court.

The AAP leaders had questioned the reluctance of

the Gujarat University to disclose copies of degree certificates awarded to Modi. Appearing for Sanjay Singh, senior advocate Rebecca John contended that there was nothing defamatory said about the University to file the defamation complaint. "It is apparent from the video that the statement is not defamatory to the University. It was not said that Gujarat University has forged the degree," John said. The

Court, however, replied that this could be argued at the trial stage. Senior advocate AM Singhvi argued that there is a jurisdictional issue involved. The Top Court, however, expressed that it will not allow two lawyers to argue for the same case. The bench eventually decided not to interfere with the trial court's summons to Singh. Solicitor General of India Tushar Mehta represented Gujarat University. The case pertains to a defamation case, filed by the Gujarat University in March 2023 accusing Arvind Kejriwal and Sanjay Singh of defamation. The AAP leaders challenged Prime Minister Narendra Modi's educational qualifications. A trial court then summoned both the Kejriwal and Singh in this defamation case in April last year, prompting the duo to move the Gujarat High Court seeking relief.

In web of spin

Bengalis can be nonplussed by the word swachh. In Hindi it means clean, but in Bengali swachchha means transparent.

The latter is a curious assertion. The public had no means of knowing who bought how many bonds, who received them, and whether they changed hands in between.

There is nothing new under the sun. The ancient Romans had a saying to describe such anomalies. Latin lucus means a wood or grove, obviously dark and shadowy, while lucere means to shine or cast light.

We live in a world of misnomers. For years after the pandemic, the railways ran 'special' trains charging express fares for the same slow 'passenger' services of yore.

Even if these trains no longer charge fancy fares, the question remains how they did so even for a single day. An official briefed the press that what mattered was not the speed or the number of stops but the classification of the train — in other words, what the railways decided to call it.

My examples are not false data or fake news in the literal sense. The facts are openly laid out as regards both railway timings and electoral bonds.

Examples range from the trivial to the momentous. Electoral bonds are obviously a more serious issue than railway timetables: it touches the heart of our democratic order.

The Qutub Minar was lit up with the colours of the Rwandan national flag on Sunday in solidarity with the people of the east-African nation in remembrance of the 100-day massacre that claimed the lives of 800,000 people in 1994.

On the occasion, Secretary (Economic Relations) Dammu Ravi of the Ministry of External Affairs represented India at the 30th commemoration of the genocide in the Rwanda capital, Kigali.

Sharing a post on X, the official spokesperson of MEA, Randhir Jaiswal, wrote, "In solidarity with the people of Rwanda, India lit up the Qutub Minar today, marking the UN International Day of Reflection on the 1994 Genocide against the Tutsi in Rwanda."

The Rwandan Patriotic Front (RPF) rebel group captured Kigali in July 1994 after a 100-day killing spree that started on



April 7, 1994, and claimed the lives of almost 800,000 people, most of them Tutsis but also moderate Hutus, according to Al Jazeera.

Notably, Dammu Ravi, the Secretary of the Ministry of External Affairs (Economic Relations), is on a visit to Rwanda, Uganda, and Kenya from April 7-12, accompanied by the Additional Secretary (East and Southern Africa), Puneet R Kundal.

On Sunday (April 7), Dammu Ravi called on MoS for Foreign Affairs James Kabarebe, Minister of Finance and Economic Planning Uzziel Ndagijimana and MoS for Agriculture Eric Rwigamba of Rwanda in Kigali.

Alcohol usage during pregnancy linked to birth abnormalities

Researchers have found that low to moderate alcohol use by pregnant patients may contribute to subtle changes in their babies' prenatal development.


The study was published in the journal, 'Alcohol Clinical and Experimental Research'. "In exploratory analyses, the effect on gestational age was more pronounced in male infants, and for birth length, it actually was stronger in females," Bakhireva said.

She cautioned that these effects should be interpreted with caution because of the study's limited statistical power to conduct sex-specific analyses and the challenges of accounting for other contributing factors.

There is a good deal of research on the prenatal effects of heavy alcohol use, usually defined as 14 drinks per week, or binge drinking, defined as four drinks or more per occasion, Bakhireva said.

"We know quite a bit from these earlier studies of heavy alcohol use about the effect on prenatal outcomes, especially preterm delivery and growth restriction, as well as neurodevelopmental outcomes, but we specifically focused on more moderate alcohol exposure because it's much more prevalent," she said.

Early pregnancy is a critical period for the formation of organs in the developing fetus, making it a particularly vulnerable window for alcohol exposure, Bakhireva said.



"Almost everybody drinks before they know they are pregnant, and risky drinking before pregnancy is predictive of drinking later on," she said. "That's a unique aspect of the study. We carefully looked at the patterns of drinking around conception and early pregnancy."

Most of the participants substantially reduced their drinking or stopped altogether once they learned they were pregnant, Bakhireva said. Even with reduced alcohol, there were some deficits seen in both male and female infants, however.

She emphasizes that larger studies that combine samples across the country are needed to replicate the findings and examine sex-specific effects further.

Putin addresses worsening flood crisis in Orenburg region

Russian President Vladimir Putin once again addressed the pressing flood situation in the Orenburg Region during discussions with Emergencies Minister Alexander Kurenkov, TASS reported, citing Kremlin Spokesman Dmitry Peskov.

"Orenburg Region Governor Denis Pasler and Emergencies Minister Alexander Kurenkov briefed the president today on the development of the flood situation in the Orenburg Region around Orsk," the spokesman said.

He added that "the president in his conversation with Kurenkov emphasised and pointed to the need for timely analysis, forecasting and taking appropriate measures regarding the situation that is unfolding with possible flooding in the Kurgan and Tyumen Regions." "The president also plans to hold telephone conversations with the leaders of these regions today," Peskov concluded, according to TASS.

According to the regional government's press service, the flood situation in Orsk is escalating according to the worst-case scenario, putting over 6,600 residential houses at risk.

"The flood situation in Orsk is developing according to the worst-case scenario, there are 6,644 residential houses in the flooded area. Eleven temporary shelters with a capacity of 8,087 places have been set up," the statement said.

In Orsk, 1,164 individuals, including 336 children, have been evacuated, with 696 people housed in nearby temporary shelters. The collapse of a dam in Orsk, the second-largest city in Russia's Orenburg Re-



gion, occurred in two locations overnight on April 6th, with another breach occurring later the same day.

Although two individuals were found dead in the flooded area, officials clarified that their deaths were unrelated to the emergency.

Authorities have declared a regional-level emergency and are urging residents to evacuate promptly, TASS reported.



Gut bacteria can influence obesity in men and women

New research has found that gut bacteria can play a key role in the onset and development of obesity, with differences in men and women, which might affect the metabolism of different nutrients and therefore the presence of bioactive molecules in the gut that influence the development of metabolic disease.

The study was published in the journal 'European Association for the Study of Obesity'.

The gut microbiota consists of a complex community of microorganisms (bacteria, viruses, fungi and protozoa) that inhabit the gastrointestinal tract. Disruption in this community (dysbiosis) significantly affects metabolic health and influences the risk of certain diseases, including obesity.

However, it is still unclear which species represent a greater or lesser likelihood of developing obesity, as well as the impact of these species on our metabolic health.

To find out more, researchers analysed metagenomic and metabolomic data from a Span-



ish population to understand the mechanisms by which these microorganisms are involved in the development of obesity.

They examined the faecal metabolome—the diverse collection of metabolites (small molecules) found in the gut and shed in faeces that are produced by gut bacteria as a byproduct of metabolising food and make their way into the bloodstream impacting health.

Overall, 361 adult volunteers (251 women/110 men, average (median age 44 years old) were included from the Spanish Obekit study—a randomised trial examining the relationship between genetic variants and the response to a hypocaloric diet.

Researchers made sure that participants in the LOW and HIGH groups were matched for sex and age. Genetic microbiota profiling was done to identify the different types, composition, diversity, and relative abundance of bacteria present in stool samples of the participants.

The analysis revealed that individuals with a HIGH OB index were characterised by significantly lower levels of Christensenella minuta—a bacterium which has consistently been linked to leanness and health.

In men, greater abundance of Parabacteroides helcogenes and Campylobacter canadensis species—were strongly associated with higher BMI, fat mass, and waist circumference. Whereas in women, greater abundance of three species—Prevotella micans, Prevotella brevis and Prevotella sacharolitica—were highly predictive of higher BMI, fat mass and waist circumference, but not in men.

In further untargeted metabolomics analyses, that looked at a broader range of metabolic compounds in the blood, researchers found variation in the abundance of certain metabolites—especially higher levels of bioactive lipids—phospholipids (implicated in the development of metabolic disease and critical modulators of insulin sensitivity) and

sphingolipids (that play a role in the development of diabetes and the emergence of vascular complications)—in participants with a HIGH OB index.

"Our findings reveal how an imbalance in distinct bacterial groups are likely to play an important role in the onset and development of obesity, with considerable differences between the sexes, which might affect the metabolism of different bioactive molecules present in the metabolome that influence the development of metabolic disease", says lead author Dr Paula Aranaz from the Centre for Nutrition Research at the University of Navarra in Spain.

She adds, "Gut microbiome composition, specifically higher levels of the Christensenella minuta bacterium, appeared to protect against obesity. Whereas the species that influence the risk of developing obesity appear to be different between the sexes and interventions to help prevent an obesity-favourable microbiome may need to be different in men and women.

LUCKNOW : Lucknow Super Giants (LSG) skipper KL Rahul continued his horrid run with the bat in the Indian Premier League (IPL), adding more fuel to the fire of speculations about his place in India's T20I set-up ahead of the ICC

T20 World Cup starting in West Indies/USA from June 1 onwards.

In the match against Gujarat Titans (GT) at Lucknow's Ekana Stadium, KL played a struggling, conservative T20 knock, scoring just 33 runs in 31 balls, with three boundaries. His runs came at a sub-par strike rate of 106.45.


Having played four IPL matches so far, KL has scored only 126 runs at an average of 31.50, with an underwhelming strike rate of 128.57. He has scored a half-century, a knock of 58 in 44 balls against RR, but has otherwise registered scores of 15 in nine balls, 20 in 14 balls and 33.

The wicketkeeper-batter has been disappointing with the bat in the IPL since the 2023 edition, a season which was cut short by an injury. In the 2023 IPL, KL

scored 274 runs in nine matches at an average of 34.25 and a sub-par strike rate of 113.22, with two half-centuries and best score of 74. Overall since IPL 2023, KL has featured in 13 matches for LSG, scoring 400 runs at an average of 33.33, with a strike rate of just over 117. He has scored three fifties, with the best score of 74. Though other numbers still seem fine, his strike rate looks really ordinary for a format that requires openers to hit big from ball one.

Of 57 players who have faced at least 150 balls across the last two IPLs, KL is the only batter with a strike rate of below 120.

This raises concern over KL's intent while batting, as Ishan Kishan (170.37 strike rate), Sanju Samson (150.84 strike rate),
