



“Enough is Enough”: President on crimes against women

Declaring that “enough is enough”, President Droupadi Murmu on Wednesday said it is time for India to wake up to the “perversion” of crimes against women and counter the mindset that sees women as “less powerful, less capable, less intelligent”.

“Those who share such views then go further and see the female as an object... We owe it to our daughters to remove the hurdles from their path of winning the freedom from fear,” Murmu said. Referring to the August 9 rape and murder of a junior doctor in a Kolkata hospital, a “dismayed and horrified” president said what is even more depressing is that it is part of a series of crimes against women. Murmu said no civilised society can allow daughters and sisters to be subjected to such atrocities.

In a big push to infrastructure development in the country, the Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) Chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Wednesday approved development of 12 smart industrial cities with an estimated investment of Rs 28,602 crores while also giving nod to three rail projects worth Rs 6,456 crore.

Under the National Industrial Corridor Development Programme (NICDP), the smart industrial cities are proposed across 10 states and strategically planned along six major corridors.

An official statement said that the industrial city projects would transform the industrial landscape of the country and create a robust network of industrial nodes and



cities that will significantly boost economic growth and global competitiveness.

“Spanning across 10 states and strategi-

cally planned along 6 major corridors, these projects represent a significant leap forward in India’s quest to enhance its manufacturing capabilities and economic growth. These industrial areas will be located in Khurpia in Uttarakhand, Rajpura-Patiala in Punjab, Dighi in Maharashtra, Palakkad in Kerala, Agra and Prayagraj in UP, Gaya in Bihar, Zaheerabad in Telangana, Orvakal and Koppurthy in AP and Jodhpur-Pali in Rajasthan,” the statement said.

The new industrial cities will be developed as greenfield smart cities. The NICDP is expected to generate significant employment opportunities, with an estimated 1 million direct jobs .

Bengal bandh: BJP, TMC workers clash; normal life hit partially

KOLKATA: Workers of Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) and the ruling Trinamool Congress clashed at several places in West Bengal on Wednesday as a 12-hour bandh called by the saffron party disrupted normal life partially, with private vehicles and taxis remaining away from roads, private offices and educational institutions reporting low attendance and many markets and commercial establishments remaining closed.

Train services were also hit in some parts of the state.

Starting 6 am, reports of scuffles between BJP and Trinamool Congress supporters kept pouring in from different districts while Calcutta High Court dismissed a petition against Bengal bandh.

Clashes took place in Kolkata’s Munshi Bazaar and Nadia district, among other areas. Many saffron party leaders were detained across the state even as BJP leader Priyangu Pandey from North 24 Parganas claimed that his car was shot at and attacked with bombs by Trinamool Congress supporters.

Sanjay Singh surrenders in UP Court in 2001 case, gets bail

Aam Aadmi Party leader and Rajya Sabha member Sanjay Singh surrendered before a special court here on Wednesday in connection with a 2001 street-protest case and was granted bail.

“Sanjay Singh surrendered in the MP-MLA court here. The court granted him bail on a surety bond of 50,000,” his advocate Madan Singh said.

The surety was deposited on the directions of the Allahabad High court which had on August 22 stayed the execution of the sentence awarded by the Sultanpur court. The special court had on January 11 last year sentenced the AAP leader to three months of rigorous imprisonment and slapped a fine for obstructing traffic and inciting violence during a protest in Uttar Pradesh’s Sultanpur district. Sanjay Singh and five others were convicted by the MP-MLA court on January 11, 2023 and their appeal was dismissed by the sessions court on August 6 this year.

MHA issues advisory against fake e-mails circulating in name of FCRA officials

The Foreign Contribution Regulation Act (FCRA) Division under the Ministry of Home Affairs has issued a public advisory against fraud emails and documents being circulated in the name of its officials.

The advisory has been issued after several complaints were received where frauds impersonating MHA officials demanded money from associations or NGOs to get FCRA services.

The copy of the advisory accessed by the ANI reads that there have been instances where fraudulent emails/communications containing fake logos, fake official email addresses,



fake documents using names of officials of the Foreign Contribution Regulation Act (FCRA) Division, Ministry of Home Affairs asking individuals/associations/NGOs to make payment for getting FCRA services are being circulated. It is informed to the general public that such fake emails/letters requesting personal information or payments should not be responded to.

AAP lodges protest, condemns Kangana Ranaut’s remarks against farmers

BUREAU CHANDIGARH: The Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) Punjab leaders, on Wednesday, gheraoed the BJP office in Chandigarh and condemned the BJP and its leader Kangana Ranaut for their anti-farmers stance.

The AAP leaders said that Kangana Ranaut’s statement is nothing new but it is the ideology of the Bharatiya Janata Party.

MLA Jagtar Singh Dayalpura (AAP Punjab Kisan Wing President) and Shaminder Singh Khinda (Kisan Wing In-charge and Chairman Agro Industry Corporation) led the protest and a large number of AAP leaders and volunteers joined the protest. The AAP leaders raised slogans against MP Kangana Ranaut and the BJP. 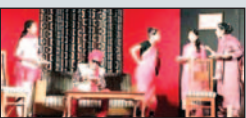

The association argues that the current provisions do not offer adequate protection, particularly considering that Shri Guru Granth Sahib Ji is revered by millions of Sikhs as a living Guru.

Thieves strike in Beetan Village, Rs. 50,000 looted



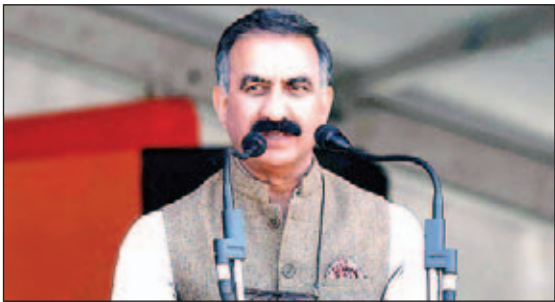

The project's objective is to reduce chemical pesticide use through systemic innovations in agroecological crop protection and to provide robust scientific data supporting the sustainability of these systems. The new line proposals will provide direct connectivity and improve mobility, providing enhanced efficiency and service reliability for Indian

Railways. The multi-tracking proposal will ease operations and reduce congestion, providing the much-required infrastructural development on the busiest sections across Indian Railways. The projects are in line with Prime Minister Narendra Modi's Vision of a New India which will make people of the region "Atmanirbhar" by way of comprehensive development in the area which will enhance their employment/ self-employment opportunities.

The projects are result of PM-Gati Shakti National Master Plan for multi-modal connectivity which have been possible through integrated planning and will provide seamless connectivity for movement of people, goods and services.

The 3 (Three) projects

covering 7 Districts in 4 States i.e., Odisha, Jharkhand West Bengal and Chhattisgarh will increase the existing network of Indian Railways by about 300 Kms.

With these projects 14 New Stations will be constructed, providing enhancing connectivity to 2 (Two) Aspirational Districts (Nuapada and East Singhbhum). New Line projects will provide connectivity to approx. 1,300 villages and about 11 Lakh population. Multi-tracking project will enhance connectivity to approx. 1,300 villages and about 19 lakh population.

Shade better

One of the major attractions of a government job is the security it offers — the pay is good and regular, market uncertainties do not disrupt the capability to pay, and it comes with a handsome set of retirement benefits, such as a lifelong pension. Under the Old Pension Scheme, employees received half of their last salary drawn plus dearness allowance as pension. It was not contributory; the amount was guaranteed. However, it was not funded and, hence, over time, the budgetary strains on government expenses began to rise, reaching a point where the guarantee to pay pension would have become a problem. As a result, the National Pension Scheme was introduced in 2009. Under this scheme, the employee made a monthly contribution of 10% of salary and the government matched it with a contribution of 14%. This constituted a kitty which, if invested in financial markets, would yield returns. But what was available at the end of the tenure of an employee was uncertain. Even if they chose to set aside some amount for an annuity, it would be quite small compared to the OPS.

The Unified Pension Scheme announced by the Central Government is a half-way solution. The employee continues to pay 10% but the government tops it up with an 18.5% contribution and a guarantee of a pension that would be 50% of the last drawn salary along with DA. This scheme offers certainty, and the amount is the same as what would have prevailed under the OPS. The only difference is that the employee makes a token contribution of 10% during the working years. This option is better for the employee than the NPS but still worse than the OPS where no contribution from the employee was required. The UPS is fiscally less strenuous for the government, but not free from possible stresses.

The assurance means that a payout is fixed, but if the returns are lower, then the kitty would fall. This would mean either higher contributions from employees, or larger government borrowing, or delays and disruptions in the payouts. The UPS is significantly better than the NPS. From the government's point of view, the social demand for old-age benefits is likely to become stronger and more widespread, transcending the government sector. It is time for the fiscal arithmetic to be worked out. The potential for higher taxes remains largely untapped, especially in a nation with an unacceptable degree of economic inequality.

1st commercial spacewalk mission delayed again

The launch of Elon Musk-led company's private charted spaceflight to launch four civilians into Earth's orbit for a historic walk in space, the first of its kind, has been delayed again, SpaceX announced on Wednesday.

The launch of 'Polaris Dawn' mission initially scheduled to launch from NASA's Kennedy Space Centre on Tuesday was delayed for August 28 due to a helium leak. The mission is now delayed again due to predictions of bad weather off the coast of Florida where the crew capsule will splash down in the ocean at the end of the flight, the company said in a post on X.

"Due to unfavorable weather forecasted in Dragon's splashdown areas off the coast of Florida, we are now standing down from tonight and tomorrow's Falcon 9 launch opportunities of Polaris Dawn," Space X said.

Teams will continue to monitor weather for favorable launch and return conditions, the company said.

"Our launch criteria are heavily constrained by forecasted splashdown weather conditions," billionaire entrepreneur and mission commander Jared Isaacman said in a post on X.

"With no ISS rendezvous and limited life support consumables, we must be absolutely sure of reentry weather before launching.

"As of now, conditions are not favorable tonight or tomorrow, so we'll assess day by day. As Elon (Musk) mentioned, Polaris Dawn is a challenging mission with critical objectives, so we'll wait for the best opportunity to ensure success," Isaacman said.

After engineers discovered a leak in a launch pad umbilical that delivers helium to the booster to push propellants to the



rocket's engines, the launch was postponed to August 28.

"Sometimes, the hardest journeys require the most patience, and we're ready to wait for the right moment," Isaacman posted on X.

Isaacman is commanding the mission along with his crewmates, former F-16 pilot Scott Poteet and two SpaceX engineers, Anna Menon and Sarah Gillis will ride to orbit atop a Falcon 9 rocket, inside a SpaceX Crew Dragon capsule which will enter into Earth's Van Allen radiation belts.



The 'Polaris Dawn' mission is set to last about 5 days once launched into an oval-shaped orbit that extends as high as 870 miles (1,400 kilometers) from Earth. This is higher than what any of the astronauts have flown since the Apollo 17 moon program in the year 1972.

On the third day of their journey, crew members will leave the spacecraft at an altitude of roughly 435 miles (700 km) above Earth, spending up to 20 minutes exposed to the vacuum of space.

Astronauts will be donning and testing the brand-new Extra-Vehicular Activity

(EVA) suits designed which SpaceX said it designed and developed in just two and a half years. Among the challenges faced by the mission will be venting the cabin to vacuum before opening the hatch since the ship does not have an airlock. 'Polaris Dawn' is the first of three planned missions in the Polaris Program, a human-spaceflight project funded and organized by Isaacman in collaboration with Elon Musk. Incidentally, Isaacman had in the year 2021 financed and commanded the Inspiration4 mission, the first all-civilian commercial flight to orbit operated by SpaceX.

Significant oil discovery announced in Egypt

Khalda Petroleum Company, operating in the Kalabsha Development Area of the Egyptian Western Desert, announced a new oil discovery in the West Fewehs-1 area.

The well was tested by drilling 270 feet into the Paleozoic sands, and the recovery on a 1-inch production opening was 7,165 barrels of oil per day with a quality of 44 degrees and 23 million cubic feet of associated gas.

Electrical logs of the well confirmed the presence of hydrocarbon indications in the Paleozoic component with a total net thickness of 462 feet.

In the meantime, Egyptian Minister of Petroleum and Mineral Resources Karim Badawi has announced a new set of incentives aimed at increasing oil and gas production during an extensive meeting with important partners in the sector.

These incentives include new mechanisms that are associated with achieving an increase in production beyond the



current rates, as well as an increase in exploratory, developmental drilling activities and production operations.

This will result in allocating the revenue generated from the increased production to settle part of the dues owed to the petroleum sector's partners and provide additional petroleum to narrow the gap between local production and consumption.

New indictment filed against Trump for 2020 election actions

Special Counsel Jack Smith on Tuesday filed a revised indictment against former President Donald Trump, refining the charges related to his attempts to overturn the 2020 election results.

While retaining the core allegations, the superseding indictment omits certain elements in response to the Supreme Court's ruling on immunity.

Sharing a post on his X, Smith said, "A superseding indictment was filed in the DC election interference case today. It streamlines the charges and supporting evidence in the original indictment, in keeping with the SCOTUS (Supreme Court of the United States) ruling re: executive immunity."

The post further said, "It circumvents the need for an evidentiary hearing (the 'mini trial') to determine what charges apply. The DOJ has stated its position in this indictment. The majority of the charges levied against Donald Trump fall outside the scope of immunity."

The reworked indictment keeps the same charges but addresses a US Supreme Court decision that broadens presidential



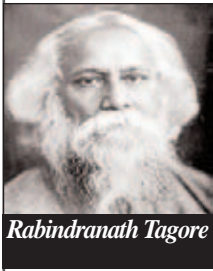
immunity, trimming away interactions Trump had with the Department of Justice and zeroing in on his role as a political candidate.

Taking to the social media platform Truth, Trump criticised Smith for filing the case against him and said, "In an effort to resurrect a 'dead' Witch Hunt in Washington, DC, in an act of desperation, and in order to save face, the illegally appointed 'Special Counsel' Deranged Jack Smith, has brought a ridiculous new indictment against me, which has all the problems of the old indictment and should be dismissed immediately. His Florida Document Hoax Case has been completely dismissed."

Model code of conduct is being openly violated in Sadhaura

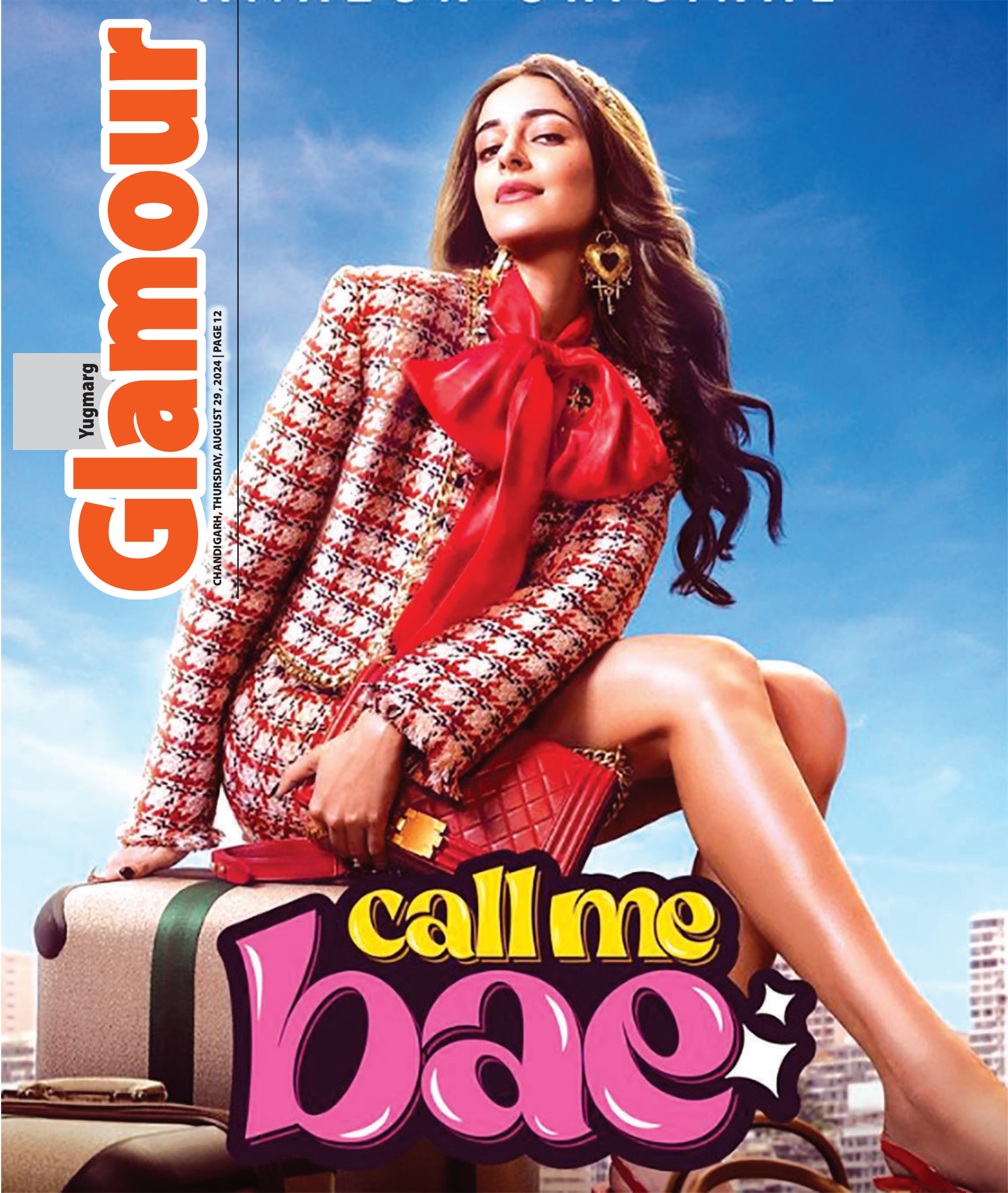

Prohibition on unauthorized storage/ transportation, use or sale of semen

BARNALA: District Magistrate Barnala Mrs. Punamdeep Kaur IAS. Using the powers granted under Article 163 of the Indian Security Act 2023, said that unauthorized storage/transportation, use or sale of semen within Barnala district is strictly prohibited, but this order is limited to Animal Development and Panchayats. All Veterinary Institutions of Punjab including Animal Hospitals/Animal Dispensaries and Polyclinics, Animal Rural Veterinary Hospitals running under Department of Rural Development and Panchayats, Punjab using semen supplied by Department of Animal Husbandry, Department of Animal Husbandry, Artificial insemination center run by Punjab Milkfed and College of Veterinary Science, Gadowas, Ludhiana, any other artificial insemination center using bovine semen processed and supplied or imported by Animal Husbandry Department Punjab and Progressive Dairy Farms Not applicable to members of the Association, Punjab, who have imported bovine semen solely for the use of their cattle. Meanwhile, in view of another order issued, District Magistrate Barnala has imposed a complete ban on public display of weapons/display through social media. Songs glorifying weapons or violence are strictly prohibited. Carrying and display of weapons in public gatherings, places of worship, wedding parties or other events is strictly prohibited. Hate speech against any community will also be banned. The above orders will remain in force till October 23, 2024.

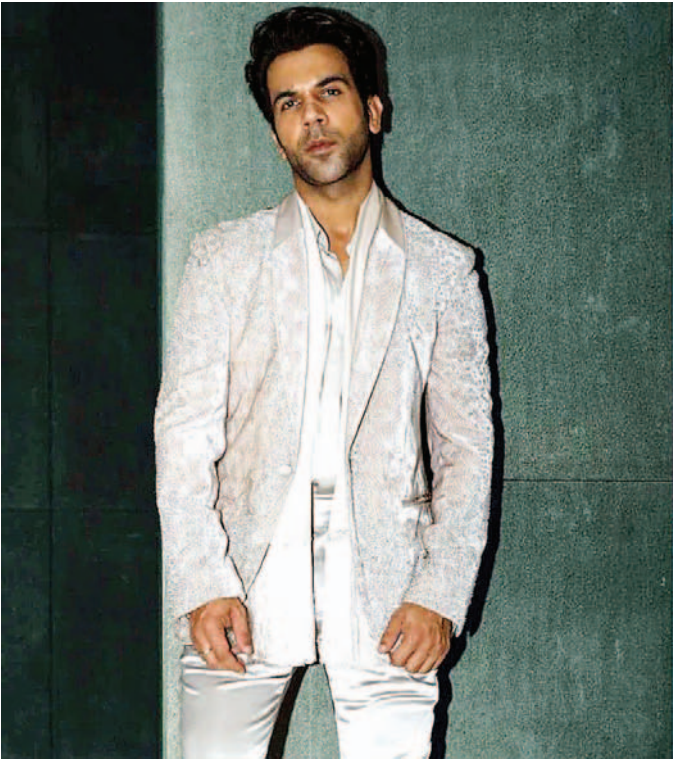
