#### **Biden hosts** Diwali celebration at **White House**

WASHINGTON: From "260 miles above the earth on the ISS," Indian-origin American astronaut Sunita Williams extended Diwali greetings and thanked US President Joe Biden for recognising the "many contributions" of the Indian community. Williams' greetings from the International Space Station (ISS) were played as a video message when President Biden on Monday hosted a Diwali celebration at the White House. The event was attended by more than 600 eminent Indian Americans, including Congressmen, officials, and corporate executives, from across the country

#### About 154 injured as firecracker **explodes**

KASARAGOD: About 154 people sustained burn injuries in a massive explosion at a fireworks storage area during the annual Theyyam festival at the Anjootambalam Veererkavu Temple in Nileshwar in the early hours of Tuesday. Firecrackers stored for the festival exploded, injuring many, Kasaragod Collector Inbasekar K said. Out of the 154 persons, 97, including women and children, were admitted to hospitals, with 8 suffering more than 80 percent burn injuries, he added. Sources said 16 people were admitted in Kanhangad District Hospital, 10 people at Mavungal Sanjeevani Hospital, 10 at Pariaram Medical College Hospital in Kannur, and 17 at Kanhangad Aishal Hospital, 3 at Kanhangad Arimala Hospital, 18 at Mims Hospital Kannur, 18 at Mangalore AJ Medical College, and others at

NEW DELHI: Targeting the Trinamool Congress and Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) over not implementing the Ayushman Bharat scheme in West Bengal and Delhi Prime Minister Narendra Modi today said the tendency to oppress ailing people for political interests is inhuman

The Prime Minister launched the Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PM-JAY) health insurance scheme for senior citizens. Under this scheme, people aged above 70 years will get a health cover up to ₹ Rs 5 lakh annually. Those already covered under the Ayushman Bharat scheme will get a top-up of ₹ 5 lakh crore. The scheme aims to benefit about 6 crore senior citizens.

There was a time when people's houses, lands, jewellery were sold for treatment. The soul of the poor trembled on hearing the cost of treatment for a serious disease. The helplessness of not being able to get treatment due to lack of money would shatter the poor. I could not see my poor brothers and sisters in this helplessness. ### NCB, Delhi Police bust meth lab in NCR; 5 held

AGENCY NEW DELHI, OCT 29

The Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) Operations unit, in a joint operation with the Special Cell of Delhi Police, busted a clandestine methamphetamine manufacturing lab in the Delhi-NCR region, officials said on Tuesday.

Acting on information that a laboratory has been established in the NCR of Delhi for the production of synthetic drugs like methamphetamine for export to other countries as well as consumption in India, in which members of the Mexican CJNG drug cartel (Cartel De Jalisco

Nueva Generacion) are also in volved, the NCB conducted a search operation in a factory in Kasana Industrial Area of district Gautam Budh Nagar on October 25, 2024 and found about 95 kg of methamphetamine in solid and liquid forms, the NCB said in a statement.

According to the statement, chemicals like Acetone, Sodium Hydroxide, Methylene Chloride, Premium Grade Ethanol, Toluene, Red Phosphorous, Ethyl Acetate, etc. and imported machinery for manufacturing were also found. Special Cell of Delhi police also participated in the operation as the drug network had footprints across several places

During preliminary inquiry, it has come out that a Delhi based businessman, who was found inside the factory at the time of the raid, along with a Tihar Jail warden. was instrumental in establishing the illegal factory, procuring chemicals required for manufacturing methamphetamine from various sources and importing the machinery. The businessman had previously been arrested by the Department of Revenue Intelligence (DRI) in an NDPS case and had been lodged in Tihar jail, where he came in contact with the jail warden who became his ac-

A Mumbai based chemist was roped in by them for manufacturing the drug and the quality of the drug was tested by a member of the Mexican cartel residing in Delhi. All 4 persons have been arrested by NCB and were produced before the magistrate on October 27, who has remanded all 4 accused to

3-day police custody, the NCB said. In follow-up action, one important member of the syndicate and close associate of a Delhi-based businessman was apprehended from the Rajouri Garden area and will be produced before the con-

cerned court.

#### **Gold rises Rs 300 to Rs 81,400** per 10 grams on Dhanteras

NEW DELHI: Gold price rose by Rs 300 to Rs 81,400 per 10 grams, near its record high level, in the national capital on Tuesday due to heavy demand for Dhanteras by jewellers and retailers, according to the All India Sarafa Association. Silver increased by Rs 200 to Rs 99,700 per kg on rising demand by industrial units and coin makers. It had closed at Rs 99,500 per kg in the previous close on Monday. Traders said they are preferring silver coins for token buying.



### J&K: Higher reaches receive fresh snowfall

The higher reaches of the Kashmir valley experienced a fresh snowfall on Tuesday amid Meteorological Centre Srinagar has predicted more snow during the next 24 hours, officials said. The Meteorological Department on Tues-

day predicted the weather will generally remain cloudy with the possibility of light rain/light snow over higher reaches of north and central Kashmir during the next 24 Kashmir weather, an independent

weather observer, Faizan Arif, said a fresh snowfall has occurred in higher areas of Bandipora, including Kilshay Top in Gurez, the higher reaches of Kupwara district, and some areas of the Pir Panjal range situated in Baramulla district. Light snow was also reported from the Zojila-Minamarg axis

on the Ladakh highway. He said there is also a possibility of snowfall over the higher reaches of Kashmir valley during the early morning hours of October 30 and thereafter the weather is likely to remain dry till November 8.





### **Central Government wants to take** revenge for farmers' movement: Kang

The Aam Aadmi Party once again attacked the BJP and the central government over the issues related to the purchase and lifting of paddy. AAP MP Malvinder Singh Kang stated that it is the routine procedure of the Food Supply Ministry of the Government of India for the FCI (Food Corporation of India) to lift old grains from its warehouses before the arrival of new grains in the mandis (markets) each year, so that there is space available for grain shifting. This process has been in place for decades, not just for a year or two.

#### High-yielding, stress-tolerant seed varieties can enhance productivity by up to 15-20%: Industry leaders

CHANDIGARH, OCT 29

Industry leaders have highlighted the need for a comprehensive review of production practices to improve rice productivity in Punjab and ensure resource conservation.

With a projected requirement of 136-150 million tonnes of rice by 2031, they emphasized the adoption of high-yielding, stress-tolerant seed varieties. Currently, only 3 to 3.5 lakh acres of the 75 lakh acres of rice acreage in Punjab are dedicated to highyielding cross-bred varieties. offering room for expansion to boost output sustainably.

Ajai Rana, FSII Chairman and CEO of Savannah Seeds, noted that hybrid rice varieties, already adopted in the USA, China, and parts of India, meet milling standards and can increase yields by up to 20% while using 30% less



This makes hybrid rice a viable option amid Punjab's declining groundwater levels and issues like stubble burning.FSII members, including Baljinder Singh Nandra of SeedWorks International. stressed that sustainable rice production relies on breeding innovations, climate-resilient seeds, and policy support to ease the transition for farmers. Farmer

#### Pregabalin medicine should not be given from pharmacy without doctor's permission: District Magistrate

District Magistrate Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, Rajesh Dhiman has issued an order using powers under Section 163 of the Indian Civil Defense Code, 2023 that Pregabalin medicine can be distributed by the pharmacy only on the basis of approval of a competent doctor and for a specified period. He directed that a complete record of this medicine should be kept by the pharmacy. He said that the Civil Surgeon has informed through his office letter number Drugs / 2023/452 dated 24.8.2023 that Pregabalin is commonly used to treat patients suffering from diseases related to fibromyalgia / neuralgia etc. as prescribed by medical experts / psychiatrists /. # Editorial New idea

he connotations of federalism must change with the times, its emphases must alter. This was the message in the inaugural lecture given by the Chief Justice of India, D.Y. Chandrachud, at the Loksatta Annual Lecture series in Mumbai University. He said that the unique nature of India's polity ensures that the strength of the Union is counterbalanced by the power of the states. Federalism in India has a distinct character in which both mutual cooperation and collaboration are necessary on the one hand and a certain degree of contestation on the other. Central to this are common constitutional goals. So far federalism meant adjusting to the political realities of the country through legislative powers. From now on federalism should be evaluated according to its ability to foster democracy and the constitutional principles of liberty, equality, fraternity and dignity. This review is necessary because the realities of contemporary existence have changed. Climate change, data privacy, artificial intelligence and cybercrime cannot be contained within the terrain of federal units, so the older conception of Union and the states is no longer adequate.

Change is possible because the Constitution itself is a transformative document, not a static one. Unlike in some Western countries, where federalism is associated with discrimination by the states, in India the strong social force of equality in the Constitution finds expression in the states' powers; it is considered positive. The CJI focused on the Constitution's emphasis on human rights as the basis of Indian federalism. It would be a "litmus test" of Indian federalism when all parts of the polity acted with cooperation and synergy to address hitherto unprecedented problems. Climate change, for example, must be fought not just by the coastal states but the entire country, just as cybercrime may attack those states which have a greater bulk of virtual transactions. Obviously, fighting these problems together would mean a far more harmonious and forward-looking relationship between the Centre and the states than that which obtains now. This vision of federalism transcends petty politics. The fostering of constitutional ideals would mean combined responsibility and care for all population groups and all regions. But attention to the parts would be based on a larger vision of sharing, fraternity or cooperation. Federalism will not be legalistic; it is the federal sprit that must be established.

# China faces stormy future as confidence in Xi crumbles

Recently circulating on social media was a photo of a Chinese soldier wedding his bride. Behind them, an enormous slogan was emblazoned: "Listen to Chairman Xi's command; Be responsible to Chairman Xi; Let Chairman Xi rest assured."

These were the kinds of slogans prevalent during the Cultural Revolution of the 1960s, promoting a personality cult for Mao Zedong.

There can be no questioning the centrality of Xi in China but as the country's economy increasingly struggles, many are questioning the direction Chairman Xi Jinping has taken China.

One who is critical of Xi is Desmond Shum, a Hong Kong-raised businessman who was once married to billionaire businesswoman Duan Weihong. Witnessing the direction Xi was taking China, Shum departed China in 2015 and, six years later, wrote Red Roulette, a book that describes corruption within the Chinese Communist Party (CCP).

In mid-October, he posted public criticism of Xi on social media, saying, "Xi is systematically dismantling the most valuable asset of the CCP: public trust. Over the past few weeks, we've witnessed the wreckage of Xi's financial policies unfolding in real-time.'

Shum continued: "To me, the more pressing issue isn't merely the financial mishaps but how Xi is eroding the longstanding trust and confidence the Chinese people once had in CCP governance. While this is probably unintentional on his part, it is definitely systematic and far-reaching."

He said previous Chinese leaders like Deng Xiaoping, Jiang Zemin and Hu Jintao were generally pragmatic. "This created a bond between the CCP and the public, rooted in the belief that the party was steering China towards continued prosperity. However,



Xi has systematically undermined this trust through a combination of political centralization, economic clampdowns and a stifling of civil society.

His leadership marks a sharp departure from the more collective and pragmatic governance approach seen in previous administrations."

Shum highlighted seven specific areas of failure. The first is political centralisation and authoritarianism, as Xi concentrated power to a degree not seen since Mao. Secondly, he has suppressed civil society and freedoms through censorship, crackdowns on non governmental organisations and the treatment of Hong Kong.

Thirdly, Xi's anti-corruption campaign, initially popular, is now viewed as a political

purge that has generated fear without rooting out corruption.

Fourthly, Xi has eroded longstanding institutional norms, such as senior cadre appointments and bureaucratic procedures.

Fifthly, Shum said, Xi is to blame for eco nomic tightening and state control, as his focus on expanding the role of state-owned enterprises came at the expense of the private sector

Sixthly, Xi grossly mishandled COVID-19, and this was perhaps the most damaging action he ever took. "After years of strict zero-COVID policies that ground daily life to a halt, the sudden reversal in late 2022 shocked the nation.

Particularly among younger generations, many view this as a defining moment

of CCP mismanagement." Finally, Shum identified nationalism and Beijing's aggressive stance on Taiwan, the South China Sea and the Indian border is a mistake. Shum concluded: "When Wen Jiabao fa-

Shum concluded: "When Wen Jiabao famously remarked that 'confidence is more important than gold' in 2008, it underscored the essential role trust plays in governance. Yet Xi has worked relentlessly--albeit unintentionally--to erode that very confidence.

His COVID management has shaken people's trust in his societal governance, and the ongoing stock market debacle calls into question his ability to lead China's economy. As trust in Xi's leadership falters, the road ahead looks increasingly bleak."

A Chatham House seminar on 24 September, titled "Can China still Prosper under Xi?" featured several experts, including Dr. Winnie King, Senior Lecturer in Chinese International Political Economy, University of Bristol. Asked about Xi's performance, she noted, "I think in terms of the international system's expectations of China, we're quite disappointed, mainly because there was a lot of hope that he would bring in reform..."

David Lubin, Michael Klein Research Fellow, Global Economy and Finance Programme, Chatham House, also participating in the seminar, said: "I think, if the question is, is he doing as much as he can do for the welfare of Chinese households, The answer is clearly no. But I don't think that's the question he's asking himself. The question he's asking himself is what can I do to promote the interests of the Chinese nation? And it's interesting that those two ideas that are so separate in the Chinese context [is] because of the way Xi Jinping feels himself to be encircled geopolitically. So economic policy is oriented around the need to protect China from geopolitical risk

# Balochistan records another Congo virus case, tally rises to 41 cases

Balochistan reported yet another case of Congo virus, increasing the number of cases to 41 this year, as per Ary News.

This is not the first instance that an epidemic of Congo virus fever has broken out in Balochistan. In late 80s and mid-90s dozens of people had died of the disease, Pakistani health sources told Ary News.

Amid the rising number of cases in the country, Pakistan's National Institute of Health (NIH) issued advisories for the prevention and control of Crimean-Congo hemorrhagic fever (CCHF).

According to the World Health Organisation, the CCHF virus causes severe viral hemorrhagic fever outbreaks and has a case fatality rate of up to 40 per cent. The virus is primarily transmitted to people from ticks and livestock animals. Human-to-human transmission can occur resulting from close contact with the blood, secretions, organs or other bodily fluids of infected persons or through contact with infected animal



blood or tissues during and immediately after slaughter. The majority of cases have occurred in people involved in the livestock industry, such as agricultural workers, slaughterhouse workers, and veterinarians. As per the WHO, human-to-human transmission can occur resulting from close contact with the blood, secretions, organs or other bodily fluids of infected persons. Hospital-acquired infections can also occur due to improper sterilization of medical equipment, reuse of needles and contamination of medical supplies.

# India sends 30 tonnes of essential medical supplies to Palestine

Indian government reaffirmed its commitment to supporting the people of Palestine with a recent shipment of 30 tonnes of medical supplies amid the ongoing conflict in the Middle East. This consignment includes essential medicines and anti-cancer drugs.

# Thai govt urged to combat human trafficking

n advocacy group has called on Thailand's government to intervene urgently to secure the release of over 100 victims of human trafficking, primarily from Laos, who are allegedly held captive by a 'Chinese mafia syndicate' in Myanmar's Kayin state.

According to a report by Radio Free Asia, the Thailand-based Civil Society Network for Victim Assistance in Human Trafficking issued an open letter to Thai Prime Minister Paetongtarn Shinawatra, detailing the plight of these victims, many of whom are trapped in areas controlled by the Democratic Karen Buddhist Army (DKBA) and the Border Guard Force (BGF).

According to the group, approximately 110 individuals from nine countries, including 19 from Laos, are caught in a web of exploitation facilitated by these armed groups, which have established a significant presence near the Thai border town of Mae Sot. The DKBA, a splinter faction of Myanmar's Karen National Union, and



the BGF, formed under junta control, have created a thriving ecosystem of illicit businesses, including casinos and online scam operations.

Human trafficking in Thailand, particularly linked to Chinese mafia networks, represents a critical issue charac-

terised by the exploitation of vulnerable populations, especially migrants from countries like Myanmar, Laos, and Cambodia. Many victims are deceived by false promises of employment and improved living conditions, ultimately finding themselves trapped in forced labour or the sex trade. A 2020 report from the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime highlights that organised crime groups, including Chinese triads, have established intricate operations in Thailand, utilising complex networks that encompass smuggling routes and fraudulent recruitment practices. Additionally, the 2023 U.S. Department of State Trafficking in Persons Report notes that corruption within law enforcement complicates efforts to combat trafficking, with some officials potentially colluding with traffickers, thereby undermining anti-trafficking initiatives. This multifaceted problem demands urgent attention and coordinated responses to protect vulnerable individuals and dismantle these criminal networks.





#### MoEFCC accused of National Medical Devices Policy violations by Industry Associations

HANDIGARH: The PHD Chamber o Commerce and Industry (PHDCCI) and the Association of Indian Medical Devices Imaging, Therapy and Radiology Devices ssociation (MITRA), the Association of Diagnostic Manufacturers of India (ADMI), and key stakeholders from the MedTech industry, held a press meet at PHD House to discuss serious concerns regarding recent Office Memorandums issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest, and Climate Change (MoEFCC), the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS), and the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW).
